CONTROL OF BLACKSPOT ALGAE IN PEBBLE & TILED SWIMMING POOLS

*If your pool is any surface other than standard pebble or tiled,
please advise our staff prior to beginning treatment.*

- First the pH of the pool water needs to be lowered to approximately 7.2, To find out how much acid is required to do that please bring in a sample of pool water to Dural Poolsmart.
- If the surface of your pool is pebble or tiled use a stainless steel brush on your telescopic handle to brush the effected area hard. This will break the surface of the black spots so that the treatment can penetrate the spots.
- Turn filtration off to allow water to settle. This will allow the treatment to work with maximum results.
- Apply Black spot Treatment directly onto the black spot algae by sprinkling on the water surface. *Sprinkle only enough to lightly dust the effected area.*
- Leave the filtration turned off overnight so that the treatment sits on the spots for the maximum possible time.
- The next day using a handheld vacuum and telescopic handle, vacuum the treated area to waste. This is to prevent any spores getting into the filter, which could re-infect the pool again at a later time.

Please note Effective control of Black spot Algae may require multiple treatments if the algae is covering a large area.
